The Privacy Notice for the Website – September 2019

This notice sets out how the School uses and protects any information that we collect about you when you use this website.

The School may collect the following information about you:

- Information about your use of our site including details of your visit such as pages viewed and resources which you may access. This can include traffic data, location and other communication data.
- Information provided voluntarily by you, for example when you register to attend an Open event.
- Information that you provide when you communicate with us by any means.

The data that we collect or is provided by you is used by the School to provide you with relevant documentation such as recruitment information and for general administrative purposes.

Security

We will take reasonable technical and organisational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information. We store all the personal information you provide on our secure password and firewall protected servers. We retain personal information for legitimate purposes and for as long as necessary as required by law.

Please be aware of the following:

- Data transmission over the internet is inherently insecure and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet.

- Our website may occasionally offer links to other websites of interest. Please be aware that if you use these links and leave our site, such sites are not governed by this Privacy Notice and you should therefore read the applicable Privacy Notice for external sites.

Cookies

A cookie, also known as a browser cookie or web cookie, is usually a small piece of data sent from a website and stored in a user's web browser. We use cookies to help our visitors navigate our School website efficiently and perform certain functions. It is possible for you to disable cookies on your web browser but you should be aware this may prevent you from accessing certain parts of our website.

Our School website uses Google Analytics, a service that generates detailed statistics about the visitors to a website. It is the most widely used website statistics service. Google Analytics uses 'performance cookies' which collect aggregated and anonymous information about how visitors use websites and help us to improve how the website works.
